Prior to our school holidays, we celebrated 'Hari Raya'. 'Hari Raya' is a celebration in which we explain the Malay customs and fasting practice where the children are taught on why they should prevent from food wastage and the value of water.

On this celebration day, Yorkland children are treated with a special homemade lunch 'Rabbit Nasi Lemak' cooked by Auntie Anny. She uses the healthy organic virgin coconut oil and fresh 'pandan' leaves for the rice making, later combining with fried fish filets, crispy anchovies and not forgetting munchies organic peanuts. The snack of Raya celebration is also a retreat to the Malay traditional 'kuih' where 'ketupat' and cookies is served for our children.

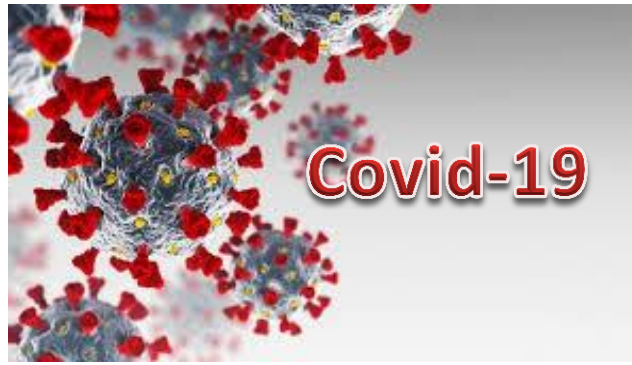

Tanabata Celebration



This is the day of the year, according to a Chinese and Japanese folktale, when the Weaver Princess and the Cowherd can meet across the Milky Way to renew their love for each other. The children will make *Tanzaku* for this celebration. *Tanzuka* is a special strip of paper on which wishes are written. *Tanzuka* and other ornaments are hung on a bamboo branch during tanabata and placed in the house as a way of entreating better things to come.
