HARVEST FESTIVAL

Dear Parents,

In preparation for our upcoming Harvest Festival, our children and teachers have been working together on a meaningful planting project. A few months ago, the children began planting Roselle again. This is not our first time growing Roselle, as the children have always enjoyed the refreshing Roselle drink. Because of this, we decided to grow it once more so that parents attending the festival can also taste and enjoy it.



The journey began with the children planting seeds in seedling pots. Once the seedlings were strong enough, they were carefully transferred into the garden bed. The children then took turns watering the plants and caring for them together with their teachers. Over time, they were excited to observe the plants grow, bloom with flowers, and eventually produce Roselle pods filled with seeds.





When the Roselle plants were ready for harvest, the children took turns picking the fruits.





After harvesting, they helped to peel the skins from the pods.



The Roselle was then dried under the hot sun and stored carefully, ready to be used later to prepare fresh Roselle juice for the festival. Some freshly harvested Roselle fruits will also be kept and used to make fresh juice, so both dried and fresh Roselle will be enjoyed during the festival.

This hands-on experience allowed the children to learn about plant growth, responsibility and the joy of sharing what they have grown with others. We look forward to celebrating the Harvest Festival together with our families and community.



We also formed a parents' committee where parents attended meetings to discuss and share their ideas, opinions, and suggestions for the upcoming festival. Through these meetings, parents worked closely together with the teachers to plan activities, organise preparations, and contribute creative ideas to make the event meaningful and enjoyable for everyone.

- 🌿 Parents are requested to **arrive by 9:00 am**. Kindly be punctual, as the programme will begin promptly at 9:00 am.
- 🌿 There will be approximately 80 people onsite, including children, teachers, parents and siblings in the garden area. We kindly ask parents to assist us by keeping an extra eye on their children's safety and whereabouts throughout the activities.
- 🌿 We kindly request everyone to keep their voices low during the presentation to ensure a respectful and focused environment.
- 🌿 For parents who are driving on the day, we kindly ask for your consideration when parking along the roadside. Please avoid blocking our neighbours' home entrances. We encourage you to use the Taman Jajar Public Car Park, which is just a short walk away and offers a pleasant start to the morning.
- 🌿 The main gate will remain closed throughout the festival and will only be opened at the end of the celebration. Please approach a staff member for assistance if you need to enter or exit the premises.
- 🌿 Personalized T-shirts, based on team colours, will be distributed prior to the festival. We kindly request that your child **wears** their team **T-shirt from home** when arriving in the morning.
- 🌿 T-shirts will also be provided to committee members, teachers and dedicated volunteers as part of the event team.
- 🌿 We will be having a picnic snack. Please **bring a picnic mat** for your family to sit on during break time. To ensure there is enough space for everyone, families are encouraged to place their mats close together. Kindly ensure that you clean up your area before leaving.
- 🌿 There is no need to bring school bags or extra clothes unless your child specifically requires them.
- 🌿 Water, Cold Rooibos tea and Roselle juice will be provided for additional refreshment.

The programme also includes an **Art Class** conducted by a **professional teacher** with many years of experience.

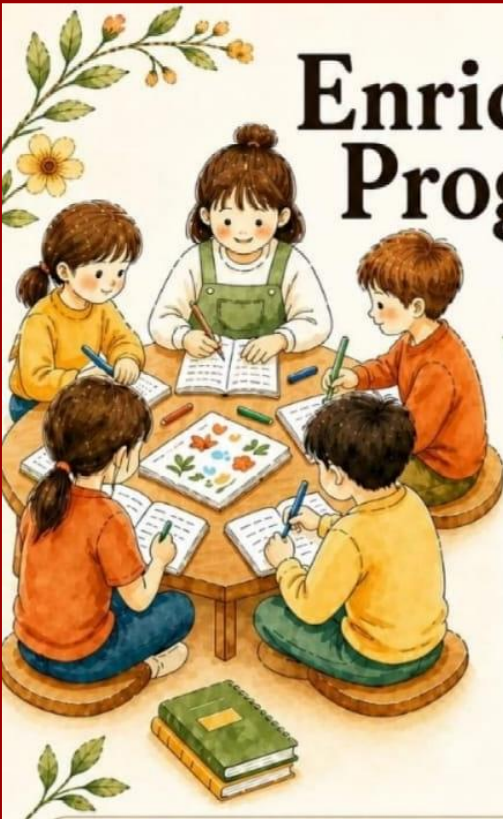
Art Class is also open to children aged **5 & 6 years old**.
